# ACTI VATI NG THE SOURCES OF ECONOMIC GROWTH INKOSOVO, 14 May 2021, Prishtina

### BACKGROUND

Kos ovo is a small developing country in Western Balkans seeking its route towards sustainable development and catching up with other European countries. Currently, Kos ovo reaches only about two-thirds of the average GDP per capita of its neighbors and just over one-tenth of the average European GDP per capita. Through its difficult past, it experienced huge disinvest ment and deindustrialization during the 90s and a long status quo under the UNMI K administration (1999-2007) until it prodaimed its independence on February 17, 2008.

Kos ovo is rich with human resources and has a young population (around 60% of the population below the age of 30). It is also rich with natural resources (coal-lignite, lead, zinc, nickel) but it faces serious difficulties to transform these resources into long term and sustainable development. With a GDP per capita of about 3,650 Euros, an une mployment rate of around 30% around 20% of the population under the povertyline, a current account deficit of around 8% of GDP (mainly driven by a huge trade deficit), budget revenues reaching around 30% of GDP and investment about 29% Kos ovo is still to enter into the phase of loge term sustainable growth to address the urgent needs of its citizens. The economic growth during the last decade has been only around 4%. An annual growth rate of 7% is required to create space for a meliorating current macroeconomic i mbalances, erad cate poverty and reduce une mployment. This situation puts policy makers and other key actors at the Kos ovar society under heavy pressure.

The evidence of the experiences of other developing countries and especially for mer developing economies has shown that good governance and good policies could create an environment in which higher growth and sustainable development could take place.
